The key features of the Paper Map Copying Licence

Currently there are 200 town and parish councils that use the paper map copying licence from Ordnance Survey. In summary, this licence allows our customers to:

- Copy unlimited amounts of original Ordnance Survey mapping to support their day-to-day business administration.
- Make copies of mapping in either paper or electronic form.
- Include copies of mapping in leaflets, in brochures and on web pages.
- Use copies of mapping as part of a professional service.
- Copy Ordnance Survey mapping in all offices where the business operates.
- Copy mapping based on Ordnance Survey mapping produced by another publisher.

Paper mapping can be defined as 'mapping or aerial photography in paper form (single sheet or within a publication) or a paper equivalent medium'.

We recommend that you read the full terms of the above licence to familiarise yourself with it and take the appropriate action.
